TERMS & CONDITIONS

- ⇒ Camp fees must be paid prior to the beginning of camp. Payment will not be taken on the night of check in.
- ⇒ For payment options see the camp registration form. Call the El Rancho office to arrange alternate payment options or to inquire about sponsorship.
- ⇒ At check in, please provide staff with the name and number of the person who will be collecting the child at the end of camp. Please call and notify staff if new arrangements are made or if you need to pick your child up early.
- ⇒ At check in you will be issued with a registration number. This number must be presented to sign out staff when collecting your child.
- ⇒ Rules are kept to a minimum and campers are expected to follow these. Most relate to standards of behaviour and respect for other persons and property. For the sake of harmony and safety in camp, discipline is firm but kind. El Rancho reserves the right to send home any young person who refuses to cooperate or for poor behaviour.
- ⇒ Fees (less \$50) will be refunded when a cancellation is made. Children sent home for poor behaviour will receive no refund. Partial refunds for children going home for other reasons (e.g. sickness) will be at the Director's discretion.
- ⇒ We do not encourage phone calls to or from home while children are at camp, except in an emergency or in the event of sickness.
- ⇒ Please do not bring valuable items to camp eg. Cell phones, ipods, electronics, walkie talkies etc. El Rancho will not be responsible for the loss of valuables.
- ⇒ All clothing and belongings should be clearly named. Lost property will be displayed at the close of camp.
- ⇒ Children attending El Rancho Camps may appear in photos and videos of camp activities that may be used for promotional purposes.



El Rancho camps:



El Rancho is an interdenominational Youth Camp sponsored by the Waikanae Christian Holiday Park Inc. All programmes are conducted under the supervision of the resident staff and assisted by a team of volunteer leaders and helpers. Registration

- Registrations are on a first come first served basis. El rancho will not hold spaces over the phone or via email.
- Only a completed and signed registration form will secure a place for your child.
- Please note the opening dates for each camp. Registrations will not be accepted prior to each camp's opening date.
- If registering through an agency, please provide the family's full address and contact numbers as well as the name of the agency being used.
- When El Rancho has received your registration form, you will be sent confirmation immediately. In the event of camp being full at the time of registration, you will be notified and placed on the waiting list.
- Your child may select up to two friends to share a cabin with. Great effort is made to honor cabin mate requests, however we cannot guarantee that your child will be placed in the same cabin as their friends. Please be mindful that cabins are put together according to age. Requests must be made on the registration form, there will be no swapping or choosing cabins on the night of check in.
- Please indicate on the registration form if your child will be arriving on public transport. Campers can be met at the Waikanae bus stop and can be taken to the bus stop at the end of camp. Please notify the El Rancho office well in advance of arrival and departure times. (For other arrangements please call and discuss with the El Rancho office.)
